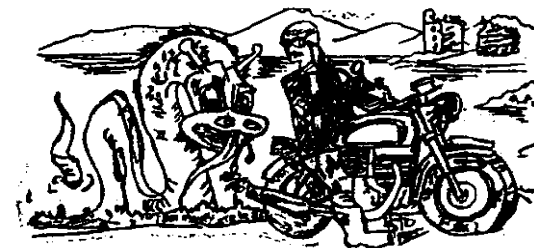

THE HIGHLAND CLASSIC MOTORCYCLE CLUB invite you and your friends to the **Twenty Seventh LOCH NESS RUN (LNR)** at Inverness on **SUNDAY, 13th JUNE 2010.**



The LNR will start and finish at THE FAIRWAYS LEISURE, Castleheather, Inverness, IV2 6AA (01463 713335), which is located on South Distribution Road. Assembly of machines will be by **10.30 am** (HCMC staff will be there from 8.30 am to welcome early arrivals) with judging commencing at **10.45 am** and the first machines (Veteran & Vintage) departing at **11:45 am**, with the rest to start in a staggered start from **12.15pm**. The route (to be notified on the day) will be about 75 miles, along main and country roads. There will also be a shorter route organised for the slower, older machines.

A MEAL WILL BE AVAILABLE UPON RETURN TO THE FAIRWAYS LEISURE AT ABOUT 3.00 pm WHEN ORDERED WITH YOUR LNR ENTRY.

Please note:- we cannot guarantee availability of meals unless ordered on your entry form.

The first 100 entries received before **31st May 2010** receives a commemorative award.

Machines will be judged in the following categories:-

- VETERAN Manufactured before 31 December 1914
- VINTAGE Manufactured between 1 January 1915 and 31 December 1930
- POST VINTAGE Manufactured between 1 January 1931 and 31 December 1945
- POST WAR Manufactured between 1 January 1946 and 31 December 1955
- EARLY CLASSIC Manufactured between 1 January 1956 and 31 December 1964
- CLASSIC Manufactured between 1 January 1965 and 31 December 1975
- MODERN CLASSIC **Manufactured between 1 January 1976 and 31 December 1990**
- SPECIAL Best Non Standard / Non-Production Machine before 31 December 1990

NOTE - NO MACHINES MANUFACTURED AFTER 1990 WILL BE ACCEPTED

PLEASE NOTE:

1. IF YOU HAVE AN HCMC CLUB TROPHY PLEASE ARRANGE FOR IT TO BE EITHER RETURNED BEFORE THE LNR DATE OR DELIVERED TO THE LNR CONTROL BEFORE 12 NOON.
2. NO UNLOADING OF TRAILERS WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN THE ASSEMBLY AREA OR THE FAIRWAYS CAR PARK. TRAILERS WILL BE GUIDED TO A SUITABLE AREA FOR UNLOADING.

AWARDS

Only machines which were entered for the LNR and take part in the run will be eligible for these awards. Any change of machine other than that entered must be notified to the LNR Secretary before the closing date.

CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE Awarded to the winners in each of the seven age categories.

BEST SPECIAL Awarded to the best non-production machine.

MILLBURN TROPHY Awarded to the rider of the oldest machine entered.

OLDEST RIDER ON THE OLDEST MACHINE Awarded to the rider/machine with the greatest combined ages.

ERIC STEVENS TROPHY Awarded to the machine/rider with the lowest aggregate total of the machine's year of manufacture and the rider's age.

(Riders up to age 40 yrs)

LEITCH TROPHY Awarded to the smallest capacity machine to complete the run.

DISTANCE AWARD Awarded to the rider who travels furthest to the event, by the shortest route from home, riding the machine which is entered. (Machines over 25 years and entered by the closing date).

FRASER TROPHY Awarded to the best Pre 1965 machine personally restored and entered by an HCMC Member.

ROAD SAFETY AWARD Awarded to the rider gaining the highest score in the Highway Code / Motorcycling History quiz.

BENT CONROD Awarded to the rider and machine of the greatest character.

BELHAVEN SHEILD Awarded to the best machine voted for by rally entrants.

CLAUDE MACKENZIE AWARD Best British Bike up to 250cc

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MACHINES ENTERED

All machines entered MUST be roadworthy and comply with the standard requirements of the Road Traffic Act for their use on public roads. Entrants should ensure that their insurance cover is valid for this type of event in accordance with the latest legislation.
